Phase 3: Develop an Implementation Strategy and Establish Design Guidelines and Supporting Policies








Objectives:

-  Develop an implementation strategy and process for the Bikeways Master Plan, including short and long term Bikeways network priorities
-  Develop bikeway design guidelines by facility type, and address liability and risk management issues
-  Recommend funding strategies and design solutions for problem areas
-  Review and revise maintenance guidelines and policies
-  Estimate the cost of the proposed Bikeways network by route segment
-  Develop policies related to public education, safe cycling and the promotion of bicycle tourism in Niagara Region

Phase 4: Draft and Final Report

Objectives:

Based on the draft outline and memo/reports prepared in previous activities, we will document:

-  The study process, including evaluation methods
-  The consultation program including comments
-  Our response and any outstanding issues
-  The recommended Bikeways and trail network plan
-  The recommended implementation strategy, including phasing plan, financial implications, policies and associated programs
-  The priority routes for 2002, including design solutions for problem areas and a public education strategy
-  Design guidelines
