A statistically valid Public Attitude Survey was conducted in the fall of 2001, for the purpose of developing a profile of cyclists in the Region and understand those physical factors that might encourage more cycling in Niagara.

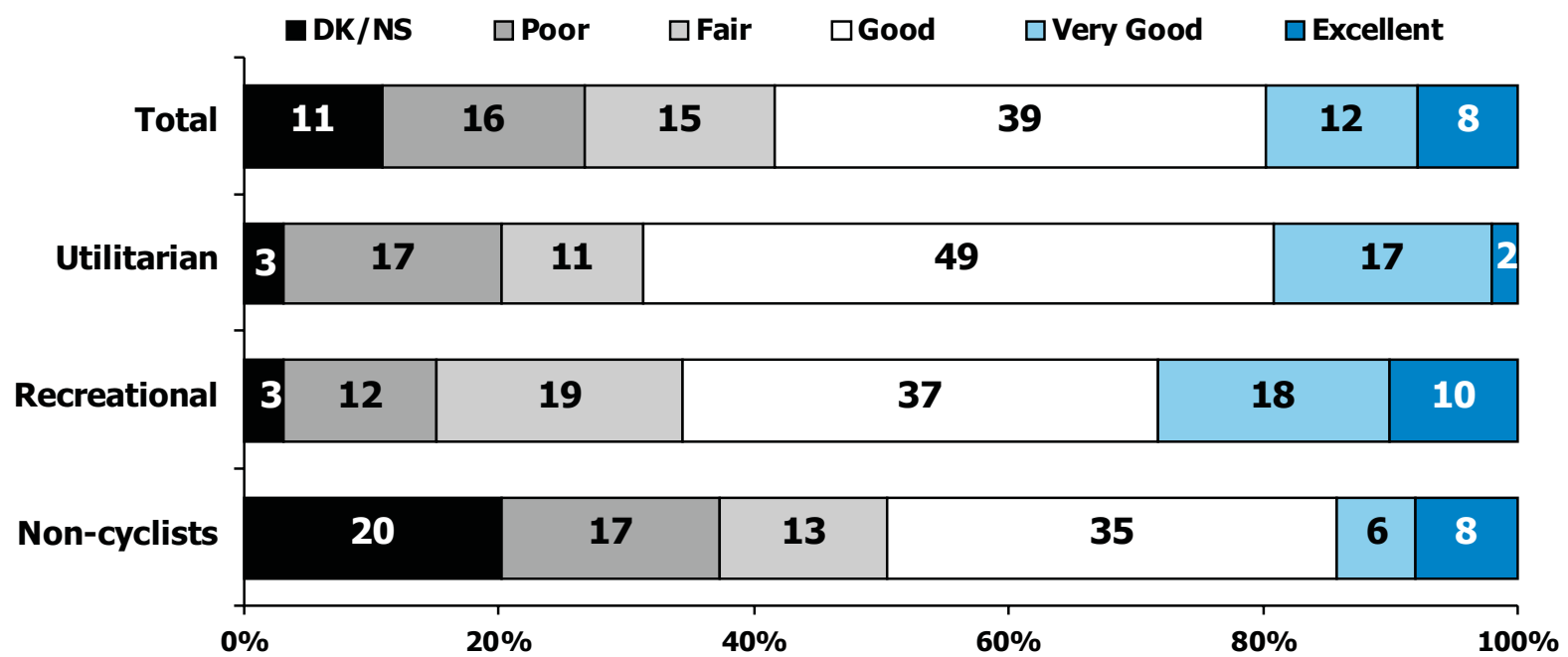
The top 3 were:

1. Provide more on-street bike lanes and paved shoulders.
2. Provide more off-street bike paths or trails.
3. Repair potholes and bad pavement.

Reasons Why Recreational Cyclists Don't Cycle To Work/School

Can't carry things on bike	13
Unsafe traffic conditions	11
Inconvenient (general)	6
Too tired/I'm lazy	5
Incompatible with work clothes	4
Prefer walking	3
Weather conditions	3
Need car for work	3
